Section A forms part of the Bus Rapid Transfer System Scheme being created within the central area of Worcester itself; the project involves road widening works to create a designated bus lane in certain parts of Bromyard Road from the A44 Roundabout down to the Broadway Grove area.

The works included widening the existing carriageway for designated bus lane, 3 junction improvement's, signalisation,

visibility improvements, improved drainage system and the construction of a new footpath/cycleway.

A key driver to the success of the project was the management and the diversions of all the main service providers. This project encouraged a partnering ethos across both the management and site teams which was evident in the way that scheme management potential problems, integrated the X12 partners, service providers into the site team and mitigated any delays which allowed the project to be completed 6 weeks early.

Close liaison with other contractors and the local community was at the heart of the success of this project. Letter drops were carried out to communicate to the local community and VolkerLaser worked closely with Worcestershire County Council's Supply Chain, their X12 Partners. The overall success of the project was reflected in a complimentary Customer Satisfaction Survey.
